

香港中國婦女會黃陳淑英紀念護理安老院

宗旨

安老院專為六十歲或以上高齡人士提供全日廿四小時的院護照顧服務,以專業技能及愛心,促進住院長者的生理、心理及社交功能,協助發展個人潛能及自主精神,並鼓勵長者積極參與社區活動,使他們能安享一個豐盛和諧的晚年。

簡史

本會於1981年獲政府撥地三千五百餘平方米用作興建安老院院址,1985年落成時,由當 年港督尤德爵士之夫人主持開幕典禮。

本院現為一提供持續照顧服務的院舍,照顧自體健至體弱的長者。全院設有260張床位, 計有安老部94張,護理部146張(其中包括緊急宿位4個),及療養部20張。

建院18年,本院致力發展多元化的院舍服務。除基本醫護、康復及個人照顧外,亦特別關注長者的精神健康狀況。1987年成立院友聯會,鼓勵長者參與服務。1988年首創老人大學,提倡及推動香港長者教育,發展長者潛能。近年更致力發展照顧老年痴呆症及長者憂鬱症的介入及治療方法。同時,本院多年來與社區團體合作無間,為社區長者提供適切的服務,提昇他們的生活質素。

THE HONG KONG CHINESE WOMEN'S CLUB MADAM WONG CHAN SOOK YING MEMORIAL CARE AND ATTENTION HOME FOR THE AGED

OBJECTIVES

The Home is designed to provide round-the-clock residential care services with professional skills and loving care to people aged 60 and above, with the objectives to promote their physical, psychological and social well-beings, to enhance the development of individual autonomy and potentials, and to encourage their participation in community activities as far as possible.

HISTORY

The Hong Kong Chinese Women's Club was granted by government a 3,500m² piece of crown land in Yau Tong to build an elderly home in 1981. It was completed in 1985 and was declared open by Lady Youde on 21 November of the same year.

The Home is a long-term care facility providing continuum of care to 260 older persons of different health conditions ranging from self-care to infirmary. There are 94 beds in the meal section, 146 beds in care-and-attention level including 4 emergency beds, as well as 20 infirmary beds.

For the past 18 years, the Home develops a spectrum of services and programmes to its residents. Apart from basic medical, nursing, restorative and personal care services, it also concerns the mental health status of senior citizens. As early as 1987, a Residents' Council was set up to encourage elder participation. Since 1988 a Senior Citizens College was established, the first of its kind in Hong Kong, to promote elderly education in Hong Kong. In recent years, the Home is committed to develop therapeutic interventions in dementia and depression care. All along, the Home has also participated actively in community projects and collaborated with numerous local groups and organizations in the district to service elders living at home.



安老院管理委員會主席報告

蕭司徒潔 太平紳士



二零零年,社署落實福利津貼改革,推行整筆過撥款制度,香港中國婦女會成為第一批參與的機構。安老院立即為未來資源削減作好準備,包括刪減個別永久性職位,轉聘合約及兼職員工;新聘職員按市值薪金聘任;諮詢全體員工達致調減年假以減少聘請替假員工支出;重新調配職務範疇以另類更適合之職級協助原本職級的工作,例如以二級工人協助廚房雜務、配葯員協助護士執葯等。同時為免影響提供服

務之質素,安老院並將所有工作專業化,包括將全部福利工作員轉聘專業社工;更改調整薪酬機制,以工作表現代替自動薪酬調整制度;同時要求所有職員每年參與及完成符合其工作要求之職業培訓課程,以提高其專業水平。連串改革後,安老院當年不單有盈餘,並可因應院友服務之需求,增聘以前社署未有資助之專業職級,如職業治療師及職業治療助理等。

除人力資源重整外,安老院並致力節省日常開支。二零零一年當社署推出業務改進計劃時,安老院致力申請撥款,終獲批兩個實驗計劃,即(一)洗衣設備改臭氧系統,以求減省人手及洗滌用品費用;及(二)全院轉換慳電膽以求節省電費開支。與此同時,亦向各有關服務供應商重新商討價格或轉聘較廉宜之供應商以減省支出,例如轉換石油氣供應商後,每月石油氣之支出可減省百分之二十,而電梯保養商亦將於今年四月起調低其收費百分之十五。

過去兩年多安老院連串的改革,只為要應付整筆過撥款帶來之財政壓力,因自 2005/06 年起當過渡期撥款完結後,安老院將要面臨每年百分之二的津貼遞減,原本按以上的改革足可以應付合共百分之二十經費之削減,但面對嚴峻的財赤,機構勢將難免面對更大幅的削減經費壓力,故安老院現正積極籌備另類融資方案,包括於明年起開拓收費的服務,以求達致自給自足,收支平衡。

我在此感謝安老院全體職員在以往一千多個的改革日子中,面對資源緊絀的時期,仍能任勞任怨地工作,本著「不怨天,不尤人,面對逆境,接受挑戰」的精神,上下同心,團結忘私地竭力保持及提升工作質素,以服務長者及社會為已任。未來持續的改革,仍有賴各級職員的努力不懈及合作,才能達致更完滿的成果。

REPORT BY THE CHAIRPERSON, HOME FOR THE AGED COMMITTEE

Mrs. Kitty SIU Hon Sum, MBE, JP

The Hong Kong Chinese Women's Club was among the first batch of agencies to join the new Lump Sum Grant subvention system when it was implemented in the year 2000/01. This was intended to give our Aged Home sufficient time to prepare for structural reforms in facing financial cut in the years to come. Immediately we made the following changes:

- 1. freezing or changing permanent, full-time posts to contract, part-time posts;
- 2. recruiting new staff at market salary value;
- 3. consultation with all staff members on reduction of annual leave days to reduce expenditure on recruitment of relief workers;
- 4. re-deployment of staff to be replaced by workers more apt to the job duties, e.g. workman to assist cook in kitchen cleansing duties; dispenser to assist nurses in medication dispensing duties, etc. In the meantime, in order to ensure that service quality would not be affected by these changes, we made further readjustments in:
- 5. professionalizing some posts such as replacing all welfare workers by social work trained professionals;
 - 6. replacing automatic salary increment with increment by merits;
- 7. requiring all staff members to partake in staff training courses periodically in order to maintain quality performance.

After a series of reforms, the Aged Home was not only able to sustain surplus for the year, but was also able to create specialist posts not previously subvented by government under the conventional subvention mode, such as the occupational therapist and occupational therapy assistant, to better meet the needs of our elderly residents.

Apart from restructuring of the human resource system, the Aged Home also endeavoured to reduce its expenditure in other charges. In 2001 when the Social Welfare Department invited application for Business Improvement Projects, our Home was finally granted 2 pilot projects for proof of effective expenses reduction: the ozone laundry system which aimed at cutting manpower and cleaning expenditure; as well as the installation of energy-saving lighting system which aimed at saving electricity charges. At the same time, we also negotiated with our suppliers for charge and fee reduction. Thus after changing our LP gas supplier we would be able to save 20% of fuel cost, and the lift maintenance company also agreed to reduce 15% of its original charge next financial year.

For all these reforms in the past 2 more years, we shall be barely able to balance the book to meet the annual reduction of 2% following the tide-over grant period starting 2005/06, ending up with an appropriated reduction of 20% of our original subvention. However, with the severe budget deficits in the more years to come, agencies will inevitably face further financial constraint and our Aged Home is now preparing for some income generating activities in the future.

I am wholeheartedly thankful to all staff members of our Aged Home for their understanding, devotion and collaboration as our partners in taking up the challenges in the past and ahead. Without their support all the above changes would not be made possible in such a smooth and satisfactory manner. We should definitely continue to count on their commitment and hardwork in our future endeavours in making changes while improving quality of our services to the senior citizens.

由於護理院宿位短缺,社署呼籲機構於現行院舍內及可行範圍內增加牀位。本院於是申請將 四樓電視廳改裝,增設8張護理宿位;及後亦獲社署批准,將6張安老部宿位轉為護理部。由於 需為四樓院友提供休憩地方,於是再將活動室改為電視廳,地下職員飯堂轉為老人大學上課活動 地點,最終犧牲的是職員宿舍-由二變為一。

RENOVATION WORKS.....IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

The past year or so witnessed a series of renovation works and improvement projects in our Home building. It is obviously no easy task to undergo the these construction and renovation works in a large complex housing over 100 staff members and 260 elderly residents mostly with frailty. We really need to applaud all our fellow residents and staff for such amazing accomplishment within such a short period. The newly renovated Home gives us a better feeling of a home after all the hard works.

ADDITION.....CONVERSION: 10/2001 - 7/2002

Owing to shortage of care-and-attention beds, the Social Welfare Department requested agencies to add beds in existing homes as far as possible. Our Home finally squeezed a space on 3/F by converting the TV room into an 8-persons bedroom. Following additional approval of conversion plan, our Home finally converted 6 meal places into care & attention beds, adding a total of 14 beds for frail elders. However, in order to retain a TV room for 3/F residents, we moved the activity room to G/F staff canteen to turn it into computer and classroom. What was finally disappeared on the floor plan was one of our staff quarters!

MAJOR RENOVATION: 6/2002 - 12/2002

Our long time planned major renovation works finally started rolling in June 2002 and practically completed by the end of the same year. A sum of over 8 million was granted by the Lotteries Fund for construction works and replacement of some furniture items.

IMPROVEMENT WORKS: 8/2002 - 12/2002

In April 2002, our Home was granted 2 Business Improvement Projects as pilot schemes which finally started installation works around August of the same year after tendering procedures. Our Home was then required to submit quarterly reports for one year period. These projects were:

- 1. Installation of Ozone Laundry System which aimed at saving manpower and cleaning expenses; and
- 2. Installation of Energy-saving Lighting System which aimed at saving electricity expenditure for the whole building. In the meantime, we needed to undertake further improvement works for the electricity system in order to comply with the WR2 licensing requirement.










年齡分佈 **AGE DISTRIBUTION**







服 由來自不同醫院及私人執業的專科醫生,包括老人科、外科、皮膚科與老人精神科,定期到院替院友診治,使他們得到專業的醫療服務。同時,鄰近屋邨執業的註冊西醫亦以優惠診金為本院長者提供診治服務。



接受過專業培訓的護士每天三班輪值為院友提供護理服務,以確保他們的健康得到充份照顧。同時為提升照護質素,本院制訂了一套完善的護理程序及草案,讓護士依據院友情況制訂切合個人需要的照顧計劃。本院並增聘配藥員以協助護士更有效率地處理院友日常服用藥物程序。

A full range of medical services are provided by visiting doctors from the public and private sectors on site including specialties in Geriatrics, Psychogeriatrics, Surgery and Dermatology on weekly or monthly basis. A General Practitioner from nearby housing estate also offers fee reduction consultation for our residents.

High quality nursing care is offered by professional nurses round-the-clock to ensure good health and well being of residents. To enhance quality and consistent care with continuous improvement of services, individual Care Plan is established to meet resident's individual needs. A series of Care Protocols and Guidelines are developed to facilitate consistent procedures in assessment, care decisions and goal setting. A dispenser is recently recruited to better manage residents' medication regimen.

A range of personal care services for the frail residents are provided by personal care workers including personal hygiene and special grooming services such as hairdressing, manicure and makeup for individual resident.

Our physiotherapy service provides thorough physical assessment and rehabilitation. Through exercise therapy, electrotherapy, health education and prescription of different assistive devices, physiotherapy helps to maintain the functional status, slow down the process of physical deterioration in aging, improve the quality of life for elderly and increase their sense of responsibility in self-care. It includes mobilizing and strengthening

exercises, co-ordination and neuro-muscular facilitation, postural and balance training, gait re-education, chest physiotherapy, electrotherapy for soft tissues injuries and pain relief. According to the health condition and needs of individual resident, we also conduct specific therapeutic classes such as fall prevention class, incontinence class, diabetes exercise class and pulmonary rehabilitation class periodically.

本院的職業治療師為有需要的長者作一個全面評估,按需要編訂治療訓練及活動,提高長者在起居生活、工作及消閒方面的獨立性及活動能力,協助長者提昇生活質素。職業治療部提供的服務包括自理訓練、吞嚥訓練、保健操、行為治療及教育講座等,並給予認知功能有缺損的長者各類型訓練及活動,包括現實導向訓練、感官訓練、感官刺激及工作坊等。

Our Home's occupational therapist administers a holistic assessment and formulates a tailor-made treatment for indivdual residents to enhance their optimal functioning in self care, work and leisure aspects. The Occupational Therapy Department provides services including self care training, swallowing class, remedial class, environmental adaptation, behavioral treatment etc. The department also provides training to those who are impaired in cognition, in classes including memory training, reality orientation, sensory training, Snoezelen and work-related tasks.

本院十分關注院友的社交和情緒狀況。註冊社工會透過個人及小組手法,促進院友的人際關係、精神健康和環境適應等功能。

本院採用「個案管理」模式來提供個人服務。社工作為「個案經理」,需負責參與評估院友的需要,與其他部門的職員共同制訂及執行院友的個人護理方案。除一般個人輔導及轉介服務外,社工透過院內跨專業部門的聯繫和緊密合作,協調內外資源分配、促進部門間的運作、定期參與跨部門的個案會議,及在有需要時邀請家人共同協商,以跟進及更新院友的護理方案,切合

其個人需要,並確保服務取得成效,務 求讓院友從入住本院前的預備工作,院 舍生活的適應及安排,以至離世或離院 前後的跟進等多方面,均獲得妥善、全 面而優質的照顧。

社工並會定期籌辦多元化的預防性、治療性及發展性小組活動,以提昇院友的精神健康及改善人際關係。本院亦會舉辦或與其他團體協辦社區活動, 鼓勵院友積極參與,進一步讓院友融入社區,避免與時代脫節。



跨部門個案會議 Multidisciplinary Case Conference

創意藝術小組

本院多位專業社工於2002年開設了多個創意藝術小組,利用多元化的媒介,包括美術創作、 舞蹈律動及音樂治療的元素,透過互動模式,讓組員能互相支援,並藉各項活動促進他們的身、 心、靈及社交功能。

「美術創作」過程是一項非言語表達的模式,用以促進自我反省、反映內心感受、整理思維及舒緩情緒。透過小組的正面互動,組員間能互相支持、提高自我評價,從而使自我形象得以提昇,期望最終從抑鬱中回復到健康平衡的情緒。

「舞蹈律動」旨在促進身體、思想及心靈的互為影響。身體動作及模式的轉變可令思想感情產生改變,故此小組利用無壓力下的身體接觸及律動,協助院友感受身體的美好,得到他人的肯定和欣賞,從中再次建立人與人之間的信任與支持。期望藉著身體的轉變引發正面影響,讓參加

者衝破身體及心靈的障礙,走出情緒低落的困境。

透過運用「音樂治療」的活動模式,如聆聽及討論不同年代的樂曲、鬆弛運動和即興創作等,鼓勵對音樂有興趣的長者參與,享受音樂活動所帶來的歡樂;促進組員間言語及非言語的溝通、情緒的舒緩和表達;並且推動組員嘗試即興音樂創作的活動,提昇他們的自我形象和自信。

SOCIAL WORK SERVICES

CASE MANAGEMENT

Our Home pays special attention to the social and psychological well-beings of the residents. Our registered social workers use individual and group approaches to enhance their inter-personal relationships, mental health functioning and environmental adaptation.

We adopt Case Management method to render services to every resident. Being Case Managers, our social workers are responsible for assessing the needs of residents, designing and implementing the Individual Care Plans in collaboration with other professionals in the multidisciplinary team. Apart from individual counseling and referral services, the social workers will coordinate internal and external resources to facilitate cooperation among various departments both inside and outside the Home for the best benefits of individual residents. They also participate in multidisciplinary case conferences regularly, involving family members whenever necessary to implement and review care plans. Through all these means, we aim at providing holistic and quality care to each resident at all times while under our care.

Our social workers also organize numerous preventive, therapeutic and developmental group activities periodically in order to enhance mental functioning and improve interpersonal relationships of our residents. Moreover, in order to promote integration and reduce feeling of disengagement, our social workers will organize, or co-organize with other local groups, community activities and projects, and encourage residents' participation as far as possible so as to help them accomplish a more abundant life.

CREATIVE ART GROUPS

In 2002, our social workers launched three psychotherapeutic groups by using some performing art media: painting, dance & movement, and music. These groups aim at enhancing and developing the physical, psychosocial, emotional & spiritual wellbeings of our residents through interactive encounters.

"Art Painting" is a form of non-verbal expression for reconstruction of ego and release of emotions. By positive group interactions and activations, members develop a sense of self appraisal and mutual support, so as to reconstruct a positive self image for better mental health functioning.



Music Therapy 音樂治療



The "Dance and Movement Group" builds on the belief that body & mind are interrelated such that change of body movement & pattern will affect change in thinking and emotions. The group helps the members to keep in touch with the beauty and strengths of their bodies under a stress-free environment, and to obtain recognition & appreciation from others so as to build trust and support among group members. Through the positive change in body movement, it hopes to reduce the depressive symptoms of the participants.

Using the techniques of "Music Therapy" comprising listening & association, discussion, relaxation exercises and improvisation concept, the group evokes pleasant and joyful feelings of our group members, thus enhances their social integration, mutual support & emotional expression. In addition, by using improvisation activities members are helped to strengthen their self confidence & self esteem.

務本院自一九八八年起,以「第三齡大學」的教育模式在院內創辦「老人大學」,為本院院友及區內長者提供學習機會,希望長者能從學習中培養生活興趣、增進日常知識、發揮個人潛能、建立自我形象及培養積極人生觀。

「老人大學」每年均提供多元化的學科給院友選擇,並向他們進行問卷調查,務求課程能切合長者的興趣及能力。「老人大學」分設「文學院」、「演藝學院」及「社會服務學院」。「文學院」旨在教授文學、現代社會科學和日常知識,以增進長者之智力發展及生活技能;「演藝學院」致力發掘長者的藝術和表演潛能,豐富長者的生活情趣;「社會服務學院」積極推動長者參與院內、外之服務,培養長者服務別人及關心社會的精神。「老人大學」每年均舉行畢業典禮,各學系會依據學生的出席率、課堂參與、日常習作及考試表現評定成績,符合學系要求者方可畢業。畢業生若能成功修滿三個學院的課程並均取得首、次名的成績,更可成為「榮譽生」,藉以嘉獎成績優異的同學。

本年度的老人大學共開辦十個學系,分別是「文學院」的中文系、香港歷史系、普通話系、中國語文系、電腦系及中國旅遊系;「演藝學院」的<u>手工藝班及太極班</u>;與及「社會服務學院」的<u>園藝家政系及交通安全隊</u>。今年共有105位長者報讀老人大學,各學系合計的報讀人次更高達314次。

SENIOR CITIZENS COLLEGE

Modeled after the University of the Third Age (U3A), our Home establishes the Senior Citizens College since 1988. It aims at providing learning opportunities for our elderly residents and senior citizens in the community to nurture their interests, enhance knowledge, develop individual potentials, build up positive self-image, and cultivate an optimistic life aspiration.

Each year the Senior Citizens College provides a variety of courses designed to cater for the needs and capacity of older persons. Courses offered in the College are organized into 3 distinct faculties: the Arts



Tai- chi Class 太極班

& Science Faculty, the Performance & Art Faculty, and the Social Service Faculty. The Arts & Science Faculty introduces students to the study of literature, language and contemporary social science in order to enhance their intelligence and life skills. The Performance & Art Faculty concentrates on developing the individual's talents in art and performance in order to enrich their life style. The Social Service Faculty encourages the older persons to actively participate in services inside and outside the Home so as to nurture their volunteering spirit. A Graduation Ceremony will be held every year for students who have successfully completed the course assignments, attended classes conscientiously, participated actively in class work, as well as passed the required examination or tests. Graduates who have successfully completed courses in all 3 faculties would be granted Outstanding Performance Award. An Honour Award will be offered to graduates who rank 1st or 2nd in class.

For the year 2002, the Senior Citizens College has offered a total of 10 courses. These courses include Chinese Language, Hong Kong History, Putonghua, Chinese Literature, Computer, and China Travel in the Arts & Science Faculty; the Handicrafts Class and Tai-chi Class in the Art & Performance Faculty; as well as Gardening & Domestic Science, and Road Safety Patrol Group in the Social Service Faculty. There are 105 senior citizens enrolled in the College this year, with an attendance frequency of 314 in all courses.




學生年齡分佈 Age Distribution of Students





各學系畢業人數 No. of Graduates by Courses







THE INTER-GENERATIONAL CO-LEARNING PROJECT

This is a community project implemented since 1998 in which we recruit volunteers from secondary schools in the Kwun Tong district to assist in providing tutorial sessions and activities in our Senior Citizens College classes during summer vacation. The project aims at increasing interactions of the older and younger generations so as to facilitate understanding between the 2 groups. It is hoped that the teenagers will be impacted by the positive life aspiration of the elders who will be mentally stimulated with increased interactions with the young.

Every year we receive enthusiastic responses from the school students, some of whom are returnees of the previous years. Prior to partaking in the service, we provide training for the students on teaching methods and techniques in working with older adults. Students are also provided with opportunities to organize recreational activities with the elders during the process. In order to give recognition to the efforts made by the younger volunteers, we arrange a prize-giving ceremony for them each year in which special awards will be presented according to their performance in the project.

務 院友聯會是本院一個歷史悠久的院友代表組織,成立於1987年,每年由院友自由選舉產生 委員而組成。聯會提供義務工作機會,讓院友透過參與管理院內事務,學習自主自决、自助互 助、服務社群的精神,並藉以培養他們對安老院的歸屬感。

院友聯會設主席、副主席、文書及司庫職位,轄下設立三個工作組,分別為膳食及清潔諮詢 組、活動工作組及義工服務組,後兩者並分設工作小組,以便更有效地推行服務:

- 1) 膳食及清潔諮詢組:關注及改善院內有關膳食及清潔服務的提供及運作。
- 2) 送舊迎新小組:發揚院友間的互助精神,以朋輩的身份協助新院友適應院舍生活,及協助 離世院友辦理有關殯葬手續;每年兩次於清明及重陽節安排掃墓活動,追思離世院友。
- 3) 大電影小組:星期日於各樓層電視廳負責電影播放。
- 4) 圖書報刊小組:負責整理報刊及書籍借閱服務,以供院友閱讀。
- 5) 小賣部:定期在各樓層提供銷售日常用品服務,以方便未能外出購物之院友。
- 6) 保安小組:由院友義工輪流當值,提高本院的保安程度。
- 7) 探病陪醫小組:由院友義工到醫院探望及關懷患病的院友,亦有陪伴院友就醫。
- 8) 廚務小組:協助本院廚房工作,如刨瓜去皮等。另外每週於各樓層按餐單編寫餐牌,供院友閱覽。

除以上定期性的工作外,聯會的委員及義工更積極參與社區服務,如探訪區內獨居長者等。為進一步鼓勵院友積極參與義務工作,發揮「老有所為」的精神,本院於二零零三年一月起,推

出「義務工作獎勵計劃」,以 積分獎勵制度,讓義工以累 積分數換取院內的其他服 務。

The Residents' Council is one of the Home's historical service features witnessing our objective of promoting autonomy and self-determination in older persons. Organized since 1987, residents are encouraged to elect representatives into the Council each year. The Council offers opportunities for volunteering services in managing internal affairs of the residents themselves. Through participation, members will learn and develop mutual help spirit in servicing others and the community as well as a sense of belongingness in the Home.

The Council is governed by Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer as well as 3 major Working Groups and Sub-Working Groups to service our residents. In general, the Residents' Council provides the following services: advises to the management on meals and laundry services; assists in coordinating social activities including orientation to new residents, funeral arrangement for the deceased residents, library and publication service, weekly film shows, tuck shop, home security service, kitchen services, escort service, as well as paying visits to hospitalized residents. Staff members will serve as Resource Persons in the groups.

Apart from servicing fellow residents, our members also participate in community services such as paying regular visits to elderly singletons living at home.

To further enhance residents' volunteering spirit, we have recently implemented a Credit Reward System allowing our volunteers to obtain Home's other services in exchange of the services they have rendered to others.

護老先鋒計劃

本院得到社會福利署「老有所為活動計劃」贊助,於 2001年5月至8月期間舉辦「護老先鋒計劃」,致力推動 院友義工從參與義務工作中宣揚「長者關懷長者」的風 氣,並讓社區人士認同居於安老院的長者仍能在社區擔當 積極的角色及有所貢獻。

計劃內容包括

1. 院友義工培訓:共18位的院友義工需學習何謂老年痴呆症、患者的情緒和行為特徵及處理方法、與患者溝通的基本技巧及協助患者的活動和治療方法;





- 2. 實習時段:由院友義工與本院職員一起帶領活動,進一 步練習與患者溝通及推行活動的技巧;及
- 3. 「護老先鋒」訓練營:邀請社區裏患癡呆症長者及其護老者一同參與兩日一夜的宿營,藉此讓長者義工協助照顧癡呆症患者,從而學以致用;而護老者亦可暫時放下照顧責任,同時間接受由本院「啟知園」職員提供之培訓課程,學習如何與癡呆症長者溝通及處理其情緒、行為問題,並與患癡呆症的家人一同享受輕鬆愉快的時光,受惠的社區人士達25人。

本計劃更得到 2001 年度「老有所為活動計劃」頒發「突顯長者貢獻獎」,以表揚長者義工的積極參與。

THE ELDERCARE PIONEER PROJECT



In May - August 2001, we obtained a grant from the Social Welfare Department's Opportunities for the Elderly Project to launch this project. It aimed at recognizing the continued contribution of elders living in institutions.

The Project comprised activities in:

1. To recruit and train 18 older residents from our Home as volunteers to assist in providing care and services to residents with dementia. The older volunteers had to undergo training and practicum in understanding and servicing dementia residents in our Home in due course;

- 2. To recruit carers and dementia sufferers living in the community for an overnight training camp on dementia care techniques;
- 3. Our trained elderly volunteers assisted in looking after the dementia sufferers in the camp while the carers attended training sessions provided by our professional staff. The training camp was well attended by 25 participants from the community.

This Project was awarded the Special Elderly Contribution Award in the 2001 Opportunities for the Elderly Project Prize-giving Ceremony.



社區協作

自強樂業護耆年

在過去的數年,單親家長領取綜援的數目日漸增加。社會福利署為了鼓勵他們多參與社交和經濟活動,於二零零二年舉辦「欣葵計劃」,為單親家長提供支援服務,從而幫助他們加強自尊、肯定自我、融入社會,並透過成功就業,改善生活質素。

為嚮應「欣葵計劃」,本院與香港小童群益會油塘青少年綜合服務中心合作,於二零零二年舉辦為期一年的先導計劃,



名為「自強樂業護者年」。本計劃共分兩期舉行,每期均由香港小童群益會在觀塘區招募單親綜 援家長,由本院提供兩日的專業培訓及兩日工作實習,讓他們學習和實踐照顧老人的知識和技 巧。成功完成課程者並可獲聘入職為本院的兼職護理助理員或二級工人。

HELP SELF TO HELP THE ELDERS PROJECT

Over the past several years, the number of single parent CSSA cases has been increasing significantly. To promote social inclusion of CSSA recipients, the Social Welfare Department develops The Ending Exclusion Project to enhance the self-image and dignity of CSSA recipients.

In response to the Ending Exclusion Project, in 2002 our Home has initiated collaboration with The Boys' and Girls' Club Association Yau Tong Children and Youth Integrated Services Centre to implement a project called Help Self to Help the Elders. The Project is implemented in two phases. In each phase, the Boys' and Girls' Club Association Yau Tong Centre recruits CSSA single parents in Kwun Tong District, while our Home provides training and practicum for them in knowledge and skills to care for older individuals. Those who are able to successfully pass the training will be recruited as our care assistants or workmen on part-time basis.

From 4/2002, our Home starts to render meal delivery service to 2 nearby elderly centres at a reduced rate in order to enable the community-dwelling elders to enjoy healthy and nutritious lunch at low cost. These units include Ko Chiu Road Yan Oi Elderly Center and Ngau Tau Kok Caritas Elderly Service.

COMMUNITY COLLABORATION

長幼一家齊參與 社區服務無彊界

此計劃為 2002/2003 年度 觀塘區安老服務聯合活動,由 2002年7月底至12月舉行。本 院共有11 位義工參加此計 劃,定期探訪區內 8 位獨居長 者。

計劃的目的為:

- 1. 透過社區教育,宏揚「長幼共融傷健一家」的精神,並建立一個關懷互愛的社區;
- 2. 藉著社區參與,增強長者 與社區內不同年齡組別人士的溝通及接觸,讓他們有被關懷的感覺;
- 3. 透過跨服務義工體驗計劃,訓練參加者成為跨代義工,學習溝通技巧,擴闊視野,為社區出力;
- 4. 義工服務體驗的心聲將輯錄成多用途月曆記事簿,派發給社區人士,將「長幼一家齊參與 社區服務無疆界」的精神推廣至整個社區。







2002/03 KWUN TONG DISTRICT JOINT FUNCTION

We have 11 volunteers participated in the annual joint function of the Kwun Tong District Elderly Services Coordinating Committee for the year 2002/03 and pay concern visits to 8 elderly singletons living in the Kwun Tong district periodically during the period July - December 2002.

The programme aims at:

- 1. building a caring and loving society through "Integration of Inter-generations, the Able-body & the Disabled";
- 2. increasing the sense of being cared for among the elders;
- 3. training volunteers in trans-generational services through cross service participation; and
- 4. promoting inter-generational and cross sector participation in community servicing.

油塘網絡

油塘網絡乃「觀塘區關懷支援網絡計劃」轄下的一個工作小組,於二零零二年十月成立。成員包括觀塘區區議員和來自政府機構、非政府機構、宗教團體、及地區團體的代表。

油塘網絡以「社區關懷」為本,於重建後之新油塘區內推動、協調及統籌地區人士、商户、居民、義工及所屬的團體,組織有效的支援網絡以協助新搬遷入住之居民,並運用社區資源,為區內有需要的個人及家庭,提供適切的關懷和協助,務求發揮社區照顧及鄰里互助的精神,建立一個關懷互愛的社區。

由成立至二零零三年三月,網絡推行了一連串的活動,包括:

- 1. 服務推廣
- 2. 油塘網絡嘉年華
- 3. 居民聚會
- 4. 地區調查

本院是油塘網絡創立成員之一,亦參與了所有有關的活動。於「油塘網絡嘉年華」中,本院派出專業護士、物理治療師、職業治療師和社工,在會上安排攤位,為區內的長者提供免費身體健康檢查,包括量血壓、驗血糖、量度體重指標、肺活量測驗和簡單視力檢查等。





THE YAU TONG NETWORK

Yau Tong Network is set up as a working group under the "Kwun Tong Community Support Networking Scheme". It is established in October 2002 with membership from government departments, district board member offices, non-government organizations, religious groups and local social organizations.

The Network aims at promoting community care in the new and developing district of Yau Tong by motivating, coordinating and organizing relevant organizations and groups to form a support network and to mobilize community resources to provide appropriate care and assistance to needy individuals and families newly moved into the district. By promoting community care and mutual help spirit, a caring and a loving society will be formed.

Since its establishment, the Network has organized several functions and activities, including:

- 1. Service Promotion
- 2. Yau Tong Network Carnival
- 3. Residents Gathering
- 4. District Survey

Our Home is one of the organizing members of the Network and has participated in all these activities. In the Yau Tong Carnival, we have rendered a booth on health check-up for elders by our professionals including nurses, physiotherapist, occupational therapist and social worker, which provides check-up items like measuring blood pressure, blood glucose, Body Mass Index (BMI), lung function test and simple eyesight test.


